SHOW FORMAT CHANGES

Changes to the In judging this year at the Nationals. (Show Reg 13.9)

This year, will see the introduction of a change of format for In Show judging for the National Dogs show only.

Only Best of Groups and Best Puppy of Groups will go through to compete for In Show. No reserves will go through to In Show. All breed level judging will remain the same as with Group level.

- The Best Puppy of Group for Toys, Terriers, Gundogs, Hounds, Working Dogs, Utility and Non-Sporting go through to compete In Show
- The Best of Group for Toys, Terriers, Gundogs, Hounds, Working Dogs, Utility and Non-Sporting go through to compete In Show

In Show judging format

Seven Puppies in ring - judge picks 4th place, then 3rd then 2nd, then Winner

Seven Best of Group dogs in ring - judge picks 4th place, then 3rd then 2nd, then Winner

There will be prizes to 4th place

Please note - this format is for the National Dog Show only. **The Cash Sash & Kai will have the full, standard In Show programme.**

Amish Challenge

The Amish Challenge was showcased in Christchurch at the 2016 National Dog Show. This was very popular attracting 70 entries. Dogs NZ is pleased to be able to offer this event again at this years Black Hawk National Dog Show in Porirua.

The "Amish Challenge" is a sweepstakes event which has previously been held at selected shows throughout Australia (and Christchurch).

To be eligible to participate in the competition the dog must be **owned and handled by its breeder**. Three cash prizes totalling \$2,000 are on offer as generously sponsored by Sue Huebner of 'Cordmaker' Pulis. The winning prize is \$1,000 and there are also First and Second 'Awards of Merit' with prize money of \$500 each.

RULES (General)

1. The competing dog must be breeder/owner handled.
2. If the dog is co-owned it must be the breeder who handles the dog and as such the breeder must also be one of the registered owners.
3. The breeder is the person/s whose is name is attached to the kennel name at the time the litter was officially registered with the respective Canine Controlling body. If the kennel name is later transferred to other parties, it is the date of registration of the litter that determines the dog's eligibility for the competition. If the kennel name is in co-ownership, multiple dogs belonging to that kennel name maybe entered but, each must be owner/breeder handled.
4. Any KENNEL NAME that has won this event, anywhere in New Zealand/Australia, is not eligible to enter the event again (Note, it is the KENNEL NAME that is excluded from further competition.)

Information for Exhibitors

Allocation of Judges and Scheduling - The National Dog Show Committee reserves the right to reallocate judges, tests and classes and alter the scheduled order of judging should circumstances require. This may include changing the day of judging. Any changes will be notified.

Carmelee Cindy Trophy (Obedience Teams Competition) - Any obedience club recognised or associated under Dogs NZ Rules can compete. See rules below.

Car Parking - Limited spaces available in the venue on a first come first served basis. \$10 per day payable at the gate.

Campervan parking - Limited overnight parking is available for self contained vehicles. Please email Lynley Bray at ndsparking@dogsnz.org.nz for further information.

Catalogues - Full Catalogue \$15.00. Obedience \$8.00. Group catalogues will be available on the day for \$2.00

Catering - Full Catering will be available.

Crufts - This show is a qualifying show for the 2019 Crufts Dog Show. The winner of Junior Dog, Junior Bitch, Best Dog and Best Bitch in each breed class are eligible. Forms on hand at the Dogs NZ administration desk in the venue.

Desexed Dogs - Spayed bitches and neutered dogs can enter a stake class but cannot enter breed classes at this Championship Show. The letter 'D' must be placed after the dog's number on the entry form. Dogs New Zealand registry records must be endorsed 'de-sexed'. There are no restrictions on desexed dogs entering Obedience, Agility, Rally-O and Working Trials.

Entries - Entries must be either made online at dogsnz.org.nz or on the National Dog Show Official Entry Form ONLY. The entry form is available online or you can contact the office and we will send them out to you. The forms are FREE.

Exhibitors Passes - Will be posted approximately four weeks prior to the event. Reporting sheets will be emailed on or about the same date replacing the hard copy exhibitor booklet.

Grooming Areas - A limited amount of Grooming spaces are available. There will be no grooming marquee this year so please book asap. All grooming must be booked online with AM and PM spaces available. Saturday grooming spaces will be available for booking and payment at the venue.

Lucky Draw - There will be 7 lucky draws for exhibitors, held on Thursday and Friday morning. You must be present to accept prize otherwise this will be redrawn. See website for further details.

Paws N Music - Competition will be held - see NDS website for full details.

Satellite Shows - Satellite shows will be held on Monday 8 October - see schedules published in due course.

Show Numbers - Will be posted with the exhibitor passes approximately four weeks prior to the event.

Stakes Classes - Exhibits entered in a breed class at the National Dog Show may be entered in a stakes class for which they are qualified. Neutered and spayed dogs may be entered in any stakes class for which they are qualified but are not eligible to be entered in a breed class. The classes are:

- **Puppy Stakes** - all breeds of puppies aged 3 - 12 calendar months on the first day of the show;
- **NZ Bred Stakes** - all breeds of NZ bred dogs aged 6 months and over.
- **Veteran Stakes** - For dogs/bitches over the age of 7 years

Temporary Permission to Show Imported Dog - A full pedigree including name and number must be at the Dogs New Zealand office by 31 July 2018 or the entry will be returned.

Trophies - An extensive range of Ribbons/Cups and prizes will be offered for competition.

Venue - Black Hawk Wellington Exhibition Centre, (Dogs NZ Head Office) 11 Prosser Street, Elsdon, Porirua.

Carmelee Cindy Trophy (Obedience Team Competition)

A. Competition

- Open for competition at the Black Hawk National Dog Show.
- Any Obedience club recognised under Dogs NZ Rules 8,9,10 and 11 may compete for the trophy.

B. Team Competition

- A team shall comprise three (3) handlers and dogs competing in three (3) separate tests.
- Teams to be notified to the National Dog Show Obedience manager before commencement of the first day of the Obedience section of the show.
- No dog may compete in more than one team.
- A handler may compete in more than one team provided it is with a different dog.

C. Calculation of Points

- Points will be allocated to each handler according to their placing in the nominated Test i.e. 1st - 1 point; 2nd - 2 points; etc.
- The points gained by each of the three handlers are added to form a team total.
- The winning team is the team with the lowest total of points
- In the event of a tie, the team with the highest overall percentage of total points in each test will be declared the winner.
